

PROTECTION CONCEPT

- ⇒ **For bigger events, a Covid-Certificate or a valid negative antigen test is required to enter the building.** The rule applies to visitors 12 years and older.
- ⇒ The **max. number of persons must not exceed 250 in the building.** We might ask you to wait until someone leaves the room.
- ⇒ **All visitors must be enabled to clean their hands regularly.** Hand disinfectants are available at the reception desk and in the exhibition if necessary. The contact surfaces and the touch screens/hands-on equipment are cleaned regularly.
- ⇒ Prefer **payment by card** (not accepted : postcard)



- ⇒ **Guided tours and workshops are allowed in groups of up to 15 people** (*children and guides included*) born in 2000 or older, subject to the following rules: wearing a mask from 12 years old; respecting capacity limits (*group counts towards the maximum number of visitors allowed*); respecting required distance.
- ⇒ **For events in front of a seated audience indoors, a maximum of 50 people are allowed as the audience; for events in outdoor areas, a maximum of 100.** The following rules must be observed: Wearing a mask from the age of 12; the seats available for the audience may be occupied by no more than one-third; compulsory seating during the entire event; consumption of food and beverages is prohibited.
- ⇒ If you feel uncomfortable and/or observe something that disturbs you, you can report to the front desk.
- ⇒ If you or people with whom you have visited the Kunsthalle get sick with Covid-19, please let us know as soon as possible.
